## WINE ESTATE.



Joh. Bapt. Schäfer is situated on the lower Nahe in Burg Layen near Rümmlenheim, just a few kilometers northeast of Bad Kreuznach. Sebastian Schäfer took over the estate from his father Johann Baptist Schäfer in 2002 as the fourth generation. Currently, 8 hectares of vineyards are in production. Sebastian Schäfer's aim is to make distinctive, individual wines that perfectly express their terroir. Since 2013 the winery has been a member of the VDP (Association of German Prädikat Wine Estates).
